FALL LANDSCAPING CHECKLIST

for Winterizing Your Outdoor Space

Lawn Care	
Rake up leaves to prevent mold and dead patches.	
Aerate the lawn to improve root health.	
Apply a fall fertilizer for strong root growth.	
Reseed bare or thin spots.	
Garden & Plants	
Cut back perennials and remove dead annuals.	
Mulch garden beds to insulate roots from winter cold.	
Divide and transplant crowded perennials.	
Protect delicate plants with burlap or frost covers.	
Pull weeds to minimize spring growth.	
Trees & Shrubs	
Prune damaged or diseased branches.	
Wrap young trees to prevent sunscald and animal damage.	
Water evergreens well before the ground freezes.	
Apply protective mulch around tree bases (but keep away from the trunk).

Outdoor Features	
	Clean and store garden tools and hoses.
	Shut off and drain outdoor water lines to avoid freezing.
	Winterize irrigation systems.

Hardscapes & Décor	
	Sweep patios, decks, and walkways to remove debris.
	Seal cracks in walkways, driveways, or patios to prevent freeze-thaw damage.
	Store or cover outdoor décor and planters.
Final Touches	
	Add seasonal mulch or compost to beds.
	Plant fall bulbs for spring blooms.
	Double-check snow removal equipment is ready for winter.
